Applications must be submitted NO LATER THAN July 1, 2011 (earlier for better locations).

GUIDELINES - EXIBITORS AND FOOD VENDORS

- Must be approved by the White Salmon Arts Council. You will be notified of acceptance.
- Artist and Exhibitors are not required to send in photos of their items but it will help in getting approved by the council.
- Spaces will be 10' X 10' and individually pre-assigned on Jewett Blvd between Estes Ave. and Main Ave. On the day of the event please contact a festival vendor official for your space assignment before setting up.
- Set up will begin at 2:00 pm Saturday and must be complete by 2:45 pm. All vehicles must be removed and booth set-up and in place by 3:00pm. Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed back into the Festival area until 10:00 pm. Booth take down must be completed by 10:45 pm as the street must be reopened by 11:00pm.
- Tents are encouraged and must be secure for wind. Exhibitors and vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, chairs, canopies and display equipment - the festival only provides the space (equipment is available from Tents & Rents - Sam Gambill (509) 637-2911 or Your Rental Center in Hood River). **No electrical outlets will be provided.**
- All sale items must be kept within the bounds of your assigned exhibition space.
- **Food vendors must abide by health department regulations, have a local health permit (attach copy with this application), a temporary food license (which must be filed 14 days in advance of the festival), and provide garbage cans inside and outside of the display area. Visit the [Klickitat County Health Department website](#) for more information.**
- Dogs and other pets are not allowed in the Festival Areas without prior approval.
- In order to maintain a safe, family-friendly atmosphere, the following items are not allowed for display or sale: noise makers, weapons of any kind (real or toy), adult oriented items, or drug paraphernalia.
