GUIDELINES - EXIBITORS AND FOOD VENDORS

- Must be pre-approved by the White Salmon Arts Council. You will be notified of acceptance.
- Artist and Exhibitors are not required to send in photos of their items but it will help in getting pre approved by the council.
- Spaces will be 12' X 12' and individually pre-assigned on Jewett Blvd between Estes Ave. and Main Ave. On the day of the event please contact a festival vendor official for your space assignment before setting up.
- Set up will begin at 10:00am Saturday and must be complete by 11:45am. All vehicles must be removed and spaces in place by 12:00pm. Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed back into the Festival area until 8:00pm. Booth take down must be completed by 9:45pm as the street must be reopened by 10:00pm.
- Exhibitors and vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, chairs, canopies and display equipment - the festival only provides the space (Equipment is available from Tents & Rents - Sam Gambill (509) 637-2911 or Your Rental Center in Hood River). **No electrical outlets will be provided.**
- All sale items must be kept within the bounds of your assigned exhibition space.
- **Food vendors must abide by health department regulations, have a local health permit and provide garbage cans inside and outside of the display area. Please attach a local health permit copy with this application.**
- Dogs and other pets are not allowed in the Festival Areas without prior approval.
- In order to maintain a safe, family-friendly atmosphere, the following items are not allowed for display or sale: noise makers, weapons of any kind (real or toy), adult oriented items, or drug paraphernalia.
